## **EXPRESSION ON INTEREST PROVISION OF MOBILE TOILETS**

The provision of mobile toilets is required at the events taking place during the Pope's visit to Malta as described underneath:

1. 5 (2 for each sex plus one for people with special needs) toilets near the Rabat Parish Church parvis in the evening of the 17<sup>th</sup> April.
2. 2 executive toilets and 22 (10 for each sex plus two for people with special needs) other toilets spread around the Granaries in Floriana on the 18<sup>th</sup> April in the morning during the mass celebrated by the Pope. One executive toilet near the altar area on the Granaries on the same day.
3. 12 (5 for each sex plus two for people with special needs) toilets at strategic places at the Valletta Waterfront during the Pope's meeting with young people on the 18<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon.

The placing of the toilets will be agreed with the Interdiocesan Organising Committee. The toilets are to be delivered when and as instructed by the security personnel. They are to be removed as soon as possible after the event is over.

The Interdiocesan Committee cannot be held responsible for any damages or losses to the toilets provided.

The supplier will be required to take out full insurance cover, as and when needed.

Details and prices are to be shown in the expression of interest.
