EXPRESSION ON INTEREST

PROVISION OF SCREENS

So as to obtain the best possible participation by people taking part in the events taking place during the visit of the Pope, expressions of interest in providing screens as follows are invited from suppliers.

One big screen and one daylight screen and 2 large LCD screens to be set up in the Rabat Parish Church, on the parvis and adjacent streets for use before and during the Pope's visit to St Paul's Grotto at Rabat and his message to the people gathered in front of St Paul's Parish Church in the evening of the 17th April.

One daylight screen to be used during the youth event taking place on the 18th April in the afternoon at the Valletta Waterfront.

Technical details, costs and all other relevant information are to be shown in the expression.

Coordination with TV broadcasters has to be guaranteed.

The screens will be put up as and when directed by security personnel and should be taken away as soon as possible after the event is over.

The Interdiocesan Committee cannot be held responsible for any damage caused to the screens and other apparatus connected to them.

The supplier will be required to take out full insurance cover, as and when needed.

Sponsorships are much appreciated and will be acknowledged in a very appropriate way.
