EXPRESSION ON INTEREST

PROVISION OF TENTS

The Interdiocesan Committee organising the events taking place during the Pope's visit to Malta invites expressions of interest from suppliers of erected tents in various sizes to be set up on the Granaries and at the Valletta Waterfront for use on the 18th of April. It is envisaged that up to 10 tents will be needed at the Granaries and 5 at the Valletta Waterfront.

The tents at the Granaries should be in place by the evening of the 17th April and those at the Waterfront by the morning of the 18th of April.

Suppliers will be responsible for the setting up and the dismantling of the tents according to an agreed schedule.

The Interdiocesan Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or loss suffered by the suppliers during the use of the tents.

Details of tent size, prices, tent furniture made available, previous experience and safety features of the tents are to be shown on the expressions of interest.

The supplier will be required to take out full insurance cover, as and when needed.

Sponsorships are much appreciated and will be acknowledged in a very appropriate way.
